Sustainable Procurement Policy

For GH Display Ltd, sustainable procurement is about using procurement practices and working with our supply chain to enhance social, economic and environmental outcomes over the entire lifecycle. The

Responsibilities

This policy applies to our workforce, business partners, suppliers and subcontractors working on our behalf. Our procurement function is expected to consider sustainability in every purchasing decision and actively manage sustainability performance throughout the contract.

Evidence should be sought from suppliers and subcontractors demonstrating their ability to meet our sustainability requirements. This should be relevant and proportionate to the products, goods or services being provided.

Sustainable Procurement Priorities

We expect our supply chain to provide solutions which align with our sustainable procurement priorities:

Compliance: ensure legal and responsible sourcing practices are applied, adhering to all local, national and international regulations.

Carbon: minimise lifecycle carbon emissions and enable reporting of scope 3 carbon emissions.

Biodiversity: minimise negative impacts on ecosystems and enable biodiversity net gain, where relevant.

Material Efficiency: give preference to materials, products and services with greatest circular-economy benefits and use the waste hierarchy to achieve waste reduction. Seek solutions which minimise single-use packaging.

Sustainable products: identify sustainable product and service opportunities, and implement sustainable certification schemes where available and relevant.

Social Value: maximise the additional social value we can deliver to local communities, through skills education and employment opportunities and spending locally, with Small and Medium Enterprises and with Social Enterprises.

Modern Slavery: identify and minimise the risks of modern slavery within our supply chain, including UK site-based labour.

Supply Chain Expectation



We require our suppliers and subcontractors to notify GH Display Ltd if they are going to use subcontractors or third-party organisations to support a contract. Suppliers and subcontractors must ensure their supply chain also comply with these requirements. Suppliers and subcontractors are required to provide a copy of their Modern Slavery Statement or equivalent document.
